

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FOUNDATION

The PGH Medical Foundation, Inc is a non-stock, non-profit organization which was established to assist the Philippine General Hospital (PGH) in achieving its noble mission of providing excellent health care for its



indigent patients. It serves as a conduit of donations coming from various civic-minded individuals, corporations, foundations and other funding agencies. The Philippine General Hospital (PGH), the premier government hospital serves more

than 500,000 patients annually, **ninety eight percent (98%) of whom are indigent.** It is beset by its shortage of funds, as the subsidy it receives from the Government of the Philippines (GOP) and the earnings from its pay patient departments, incomes from the laboratory procedures and pharmacy sales are insufficient to underwrite all its essential services. The Foundation was organized in 1997 by the then PGH Director Antonio Montalban together with some concerned doctors of the hospital and prominent community leaders. However, it became fully operational only in 2003 when it has become a major partner of PGH. The Foundation is a registered donee institution certified by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), and registered with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) with **DSWD Registration No.: NCR-R-000001-2009**

“We envision to be a globally recognized philanthropic organization, a model among volunteer institutions for its support of the less-privileged Filipino through the services and projects of the Philippine General Hospital (PGH).”

MISSION

“We are a community of committed volunteers generating resources in support of the health and welfare of the Filipino people through the various projects of the Philippine General Hospital as the national university hospital in the fields of service, research and training.”

“We serve as a link between socially-concerned benefactors and the less-privileged Filipinos served by the PGH.”

“We act as responsible stewards of generated funds, ensuring that these are optimally utilized for the intended purpose.”



OBJECTIVES

To achieve its objectives the Foundation conducts many projects at PGH, the more prominent of these are the following:

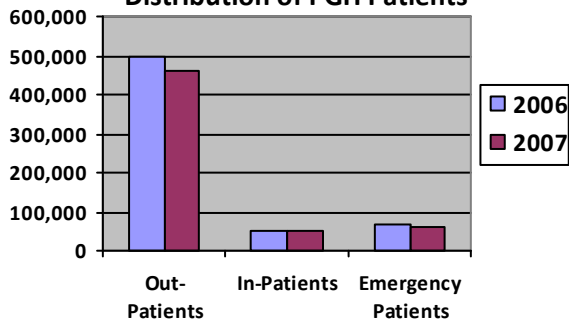
- Direct assistance to indigent patients for the procurement of medicines and supplies as well as laboratory procedures;
- Infrastructure renovation – the hospital being century old needs updating, replacement and refurbishing of its facilities;
- Provision of equipments and materials, i.e. linens, instruments, air conditioning units, etc;
- Assistance in relevant training and research;
- Support of the volunteer program which provides assistance to patients in various out-patient clinics.

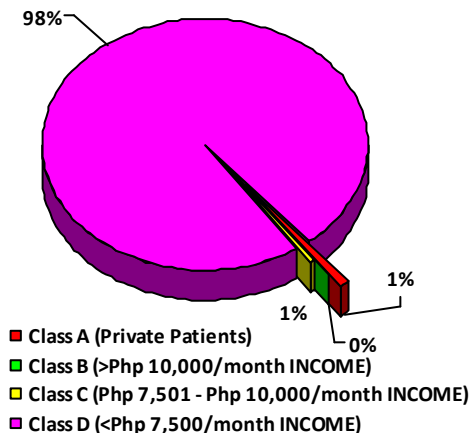

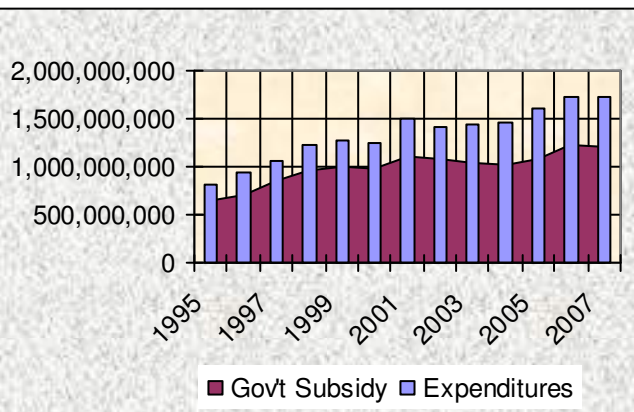
Distribution of PGH Patients
