PGH Director received 75 wheelchairs, 15 chemotherapy chairs and boxes of medicines thru PGHMFI





Valuable donations from good Samaritans were officially turned over to PGHMFI on February 11, 2019 at the Social Hall of PGH Nurses Home, for distribution to deserving marginalized beneficiaries from charity wards of PGH. The activity was facilitated by Ms. Diana Joanne R. Dee, a member of PGHMFI Executive Committee together with the Foundation's Secretariat. PGH Director Dr. Gerardo Legaspi, so with different department chairmen, witnessed the momentous event.

Donated to PGHMFI for PGH charity patients were 75 wheelchairs from Ms. Christine Fulgencio of Quezon City who generated funds from her friends during her birthday celebration for the purchase of said wheelchairs. Likewise, 15 chemotherapy chairs were granted by Kristian Gerhard Jebsen Foundation thru Mr. Menardo Boado and colleagues which were jointly received by PGH Director, Dr. Gerardo Legaspi and Cancer Institute Chairman, Dr. Jorge Ignacio.

Boxes of medicines from an anonymous donor amounting to Php100,000.00 were, initially handed to Director Legaspi, to support medical services in charity wards. Additional medicines worth Php50,000.00 and Php30,000.00, respectively, were also donated by the same anonymous donor to PGH charity patients through the PGH Medical Foundation, Inc.

PGH Director Gerardo Legaspi received 15 chemotherapy chairs for the Cancer Institute donated by KGJF. The items are now being used by cancer patients during their chemotherapy treatment in the hospital.

Globe Telecom Inc. raised Php 1.4 M for children clinic with cancer cases

sticker artworks. The designs were carefully chosen and customized by artists from Globe Creative's and Visual Management team to fit the overall look and feel of the clinic.

The names of the consultation rooms were also patterned after key Star Wars characters like Rey, Darth Vader, Hans Solo and Princess Leah. There is also a height chart with various characters in it. The designs were made very colorful to serve as "happy distractions" for the children who undergo treatment at the clinic.

Finally, the newly renovated Pediatric Hematology -Oncology Clinic was turned over to the PGH management team recently. Dr. Alcasabas said they already started using the clinic prior to the turnover and saw the smiles on the children's faces when they step into the clinic. "The clinic has two parts. The first is the consultation area where we discuss the cancer diagnosis with the family; and the other is the procedure area. This is where the patients get their chemotherapy infusion while they watch television or read books. There is also a part where procedures done. The designs on the ceiling provide a positive distraction for them (from anxiety and fear), as they await the anesthesiologist and oncologist. The doctors too and some adult patients are also happy with the way the center turned out. It's a happy place that gives comfort," Dr. Alcasabas added.

The hospital is also looking forward to partner with Globe in their future projects which include, among others, to further their research to improve treatment of cancer patients and coming up with standard operating procedures.

Hematology Oncology Clinic renovation sometime in 2016, Philippine General Hospital and the PGH Medical Foundation,

Inc., saw the need to renovate the Children's Hematology Oncology Clinic at the Cancer Institute to make more conducive for children with cancer cases.

According to Dr. Ana Patricia Alcasabas, the out-patient clinic sees around 400 children with cancer each month. The most common diagnosis are leukemia, brain tumors, eye cancer and bone cancer. Of these, about 300 children will undergo procedures such chemotherapy, bone marrow aspirations and lumbar taps in the clinic. "Natatakot ang mga bata, 'pag pumupunta sila dito, kasi tutusukan sila sa likod (the children are scared when they come to clinic because of the injections.) We wanted a clinic environment that promotes well being and positive energy.

After consulting with PGH Medical Foundation President, Dr. Telesforo E. Gana, Jr., it was decided to pursue the project and solicit the help of Globe Telecom. which has been already actively participating in the Foundation's gift-giving activities.



The Walt Disney Company - Philippines contributed to the project by sharing their Star Wars designs and sponsoring the printing of all wall




Inauguration of Hematology - Oncology Clinic at the Cancer Institute, Philippine General Hospital on January 17, 2019.
