PGHMF I “Partners in Emergency Care”

The World Health Organization lifted the public health emergency of international concern for COVID-19 in May of this year. However, the challenges related to this health issue are still around. Medical and public health institutions all over the world are still focused on making sure that communities remain vigilant about the impact of this disease. Thus, government hospitals like the PGH continue to strive to improve and strengthen its provision of emergency medical services in this changing health landscape. This cannot be done successfully without the assistance of other stakeholders, including partner organizations that serve as channels for various donations from kind-hearted individuals and groups.

In the last 2 years, the Philippine General Hospital Emergency Medical Services was very fortunate to be the recipient of 3 ambulances facilitated by the PGH Medical Foundation. Two were donated by the S&P Global Foundation Fund and one was donated by CTBC Bank.

The donation of these vehicles has been a tremendous help in the provision of emergency medical services by PGH, especially during the height of the pandemic, when there was an urgent need to provide separate ambulances for COVID and non-COVID patients.

In the last 2 years, the PGH EMS has provided emergency medical services to more than 1000 patients. These include patients requiring emergency treatment in the field or community, patients for inter-facility transfers, those requiring procedures in other medical institutions, and those for home conduction. The EMS teams also served communities by providing medical coverage for mass gatherings such as sports activities, religious events, university ceremonies, and other large events. The EMS teams provided standby medical support during the various fire and earthquake drills conducted by the hospital as well as the UP Manila campus.

The emergency medical services will not be complete without the proper equipment to go with the ambulances. Some of these important tools such as transport ventilators, pulse oximeters, defibrillators, and other devices were donated through the PGH Medical Foundation. Proper training in the use of these equipment, including procedures for cleaning and maintenance were also provided through the distributors.

The proper and efficient use of these medical equipment and transportation will not be possible without the dedication of the personnel of the Emergency Medical Services Section of the hospital. With support for their continuous training and provision of state of the art and up-to-date tools at their disposal, as well as improved processes and protocols, patients and communities can expect high-quality emergency care.

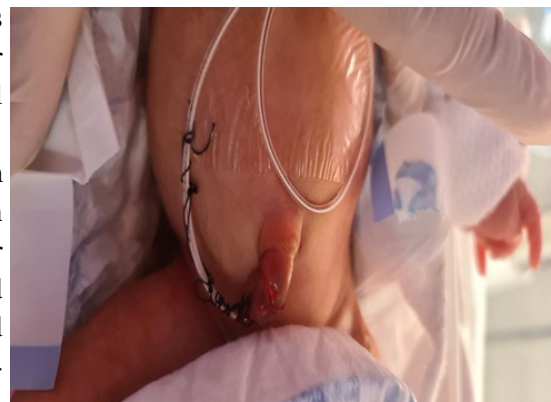
“PGHMF’s Timely response to the request of the Division of Newborn Medicine”



Turn over Donation of Vygon Umbilical Catheter to the Division of New born Medicine, Department of Pediatrics

The PGH Medical Foundation, Inc. has been a constant donor for the neonatal intensive care needs. Last February 2022, we have received 8 boxes of umbilical catheter. A total of 120 patients benefitted from this donation. The Division of Newborn Medicine is grateful to the PGH Medical Foundation for its continuous support for our patients at the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.

Critical patients in the NICU warrant insertion of umbilical vein catheter to provide for uninterrupted delivery of medications and fluids. Umbilical vein catheterization utilizes the umbilical stump in a

neonate as a site for central venous access up to maximum of 14 days. Due to increasing patients the neonatal intensive care unit caters to the demand for the use of an umbilical venous catheter also increases.

PGH Medical Foundation Inc. Respond to Division of Newborn Medicine’s Need

The Division of Newborn Medicine, Department of Pediatrics is currently applying for Philhealth Z Benefits package for Premature and Small Newborns. One of their requirements is the availability of oxygen blender in our Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.

In response to such need, the PGH Medical Foundation, Inc. has provided us with funds for the procurement of oxygen blender. Our division is always grateful for their support in our endeavor in improving patient care and neonatal outcomes.

The oxygen blender is a mixing device that permits mixing of oxygen with compressed air, either from a wall outlet or from a tank. Resuscitation guidelines recommend that the most appropriate and accurate way to administer oxygen in the delivery room is by use of blender. In response to resuscitation, oxygen needs to be titrated in a graded manner. Blender is required for optimal oxygen delivery, weaning and use of continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP).

Unrestricted use of oxygen leads to hyperoxia, release of oxygen free radicals and oxidative stress causing organ dysfunction, disease, and death. Of major concern is retinopathy of prematurity (ROP), which is a leading cause of avoidable blindness in preterm and term infants.

“A Small Gesture Can Feed A Big Dream, Donate Breastmilk ”

The Human Milk Bank and Lactation Unit is in the provision of milk for lactation mothers who are constant need of donor milk. Though the Unit’s participation in the regular milk letting activities outside of PGH, is not yet back to its pre-pandemic levels. We were able to assist and collect donor milk in 3 Milk Letting events in the year 2022. These were in August, October and December.

Presently, due to the increasing number of patients approaching the pre-pandemic levels, the volume of milk needed per month to sustain our patients has also increased from an average of 180 liters per month to 276 liters per month. The support of the PGH Medical Foundation to the Human Milk Bank and Lactation Unit has resulted in our ability to supply



safe, pasteurized donor milk to at least 930 preterm or sick newborns for the year 2022.

The Milk Bank is currently working together with the PGH Medical Foundation to procure another pasteurizer to be placed in Ward 15 to augment operations as well as to improve the current services of the Unit through their gracious assistance in procuring the necessary supplies for its daily operations. The Breastfeeding Committee, together with the Division of Newborn Medicine is grateful to the PGH Medical Foundation for their unwavering support for the benefit of our patients in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.

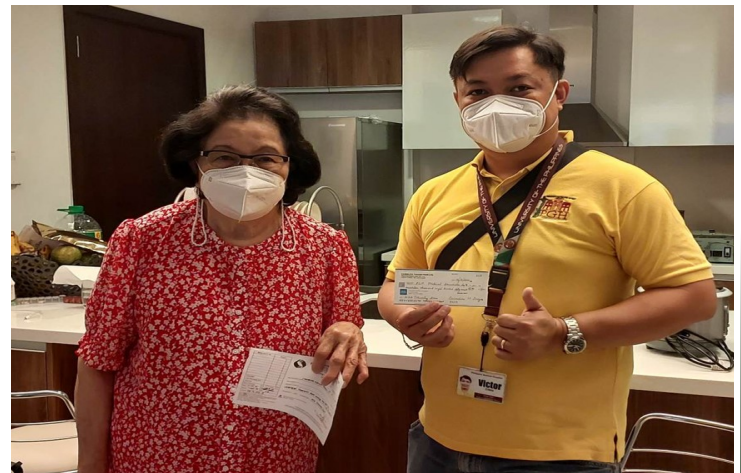

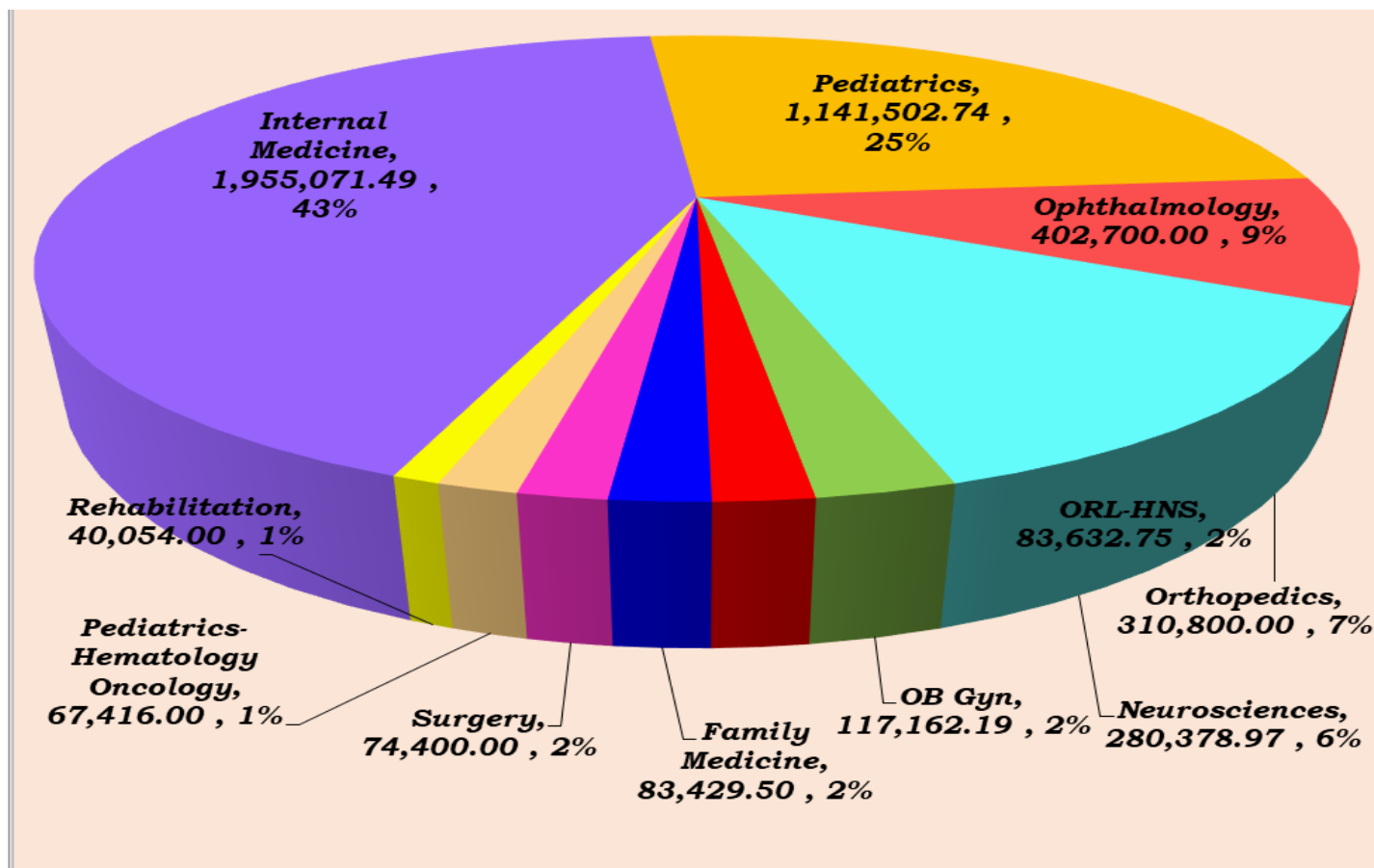


Dear Sir/Madam,

Pagpalain po kayo ng Maykapal at muli, kami ay nagpapasalamat sa inyo pong kabutihán.





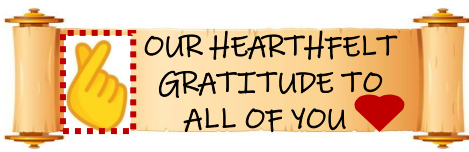
