Strategic Planning Workshop: A compass for success!

Ushering 2023, the management of the PGHMF I led by its Chairman and President, Dr. Telesforo E. Gana, Jr., decided to involve the members of both the Board of Trustees and the Executive Committee together with the Secretariat team to concretize its plans for the Foundation for the next five (5) years under the guidance of an expert in the person of Ms. Renee Bayangos, a volunteer member of the technical working group of Philippine Council for NGO Certification (PCNC).

In April 2023, the PGHMF I President, Dr. Telesforo E. Gana, Jr., invited members of the Board of Trustees and Executive Committee to form an Ad Hoc Committee to undertake a 2-part series of Strategic Planning Workshop to determine the direction of the Foundation for the next five (5) years.

The first part of the Strategic Planning Workshop, which was held in Canyon de Boracay, Aklan, resulted in PGHMF I's new vision, mission, and CORE Values and six (6) strategic goals necessary for a 5-year plan to go with the current trends in NGOs. Dr. Gana believed that an out-of-town venue for this undertaking would allow the members to focus on their tasks and deliver their output promptly.

In addition, the PGHMF I established its Disaster Management Plan and Retirement Policy Plan in compliance with PCNC and DOLE requirements.

The second part of this activity held in Makati City dealt with the details of the identified six (6) strategic goals and their KRAs and KPIs for five (5) years starting in 2023.

An overall assessment of the activity, the PGHMF I's performance management is expected to pursue its goals time-bound.

The Elixir of Life for Peritoneal Dialysis Patients

Our PGH Peritoneal Dialysis Unit (PD Unit) has been catering to both adult and pediatric patients who need renal replacement therapy with the ultimate goal of providing adequate care and maintaining good quality of life despite their comorbidities. We are very blessed to have been provided by the PGH Medical Foundation Incorporated with equipment that allow us to achieve this to provide better services to our patients on dialysis. Include these the Fresenius Body Composition Monitor, SunTech Oscar 2 Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitor, and ESAOTE MyLab Gamma ultrasound unit. Since their acquisition, we have been able to perform the following procedures for our patient that guide in our management of their respective renal diseases such as the bioimpedance analysis to guide fluid therapy in patients with chronic or acute renal failure; 24-hour ambulatory blood pressure monitoring to confirm and assess cardiovascular impact of hypertension; and bedside point-of-care ultrasound to assess kidney size, parenchymal characteristics, presence of obstruction and degree if present - all of which aid the clinicians in decision-making.

The main service provided by the PD Unit is the provision of peritoneal dialysis training and supplies for patients on peritoneal dialysis. The unit is able to offer PhilHealth Z Package benefits for our indigent patients providing 84 dialysis bags and corresponding disinfection caps monthly for their continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis therapy.

For unexplained reasons, PhilHealth suspended the peritoneal dialysis unit accreditation (last year 2023), curtailing the PD Z-package benefits of our patients dependent on this life-sustaining therapy. Our peritoneal dialysis patients were then left without supplies for one month. As we all know, while awaiting a kidney transplant, dialysis is the lifeline of patients with end-stage kidney disease (ESKD). Skipping dialysis therapy for more than three days can be devastating, most often leading to patient demise. Our PD unit has no other recourse but to ask for generous contributions from kind-hearted donors. With the help of the PGH Medical Foundation, the PD unit was able to provide our patients with 2880 bags of 1.5% PD solution, 300 bags of 2.5% PD solution, and 3180 minicaps.

It is with immense gratitude that we acknowledge the exceptional contribution of our selfless donors through the PGH Medical Foundation whose act of kindness has saved the lives of our patients dependent on peritoneal dialysis. To our extraordinary donors, whose names we may not know but whose selfless act we shall forever cherish, we cannot thank them enough.

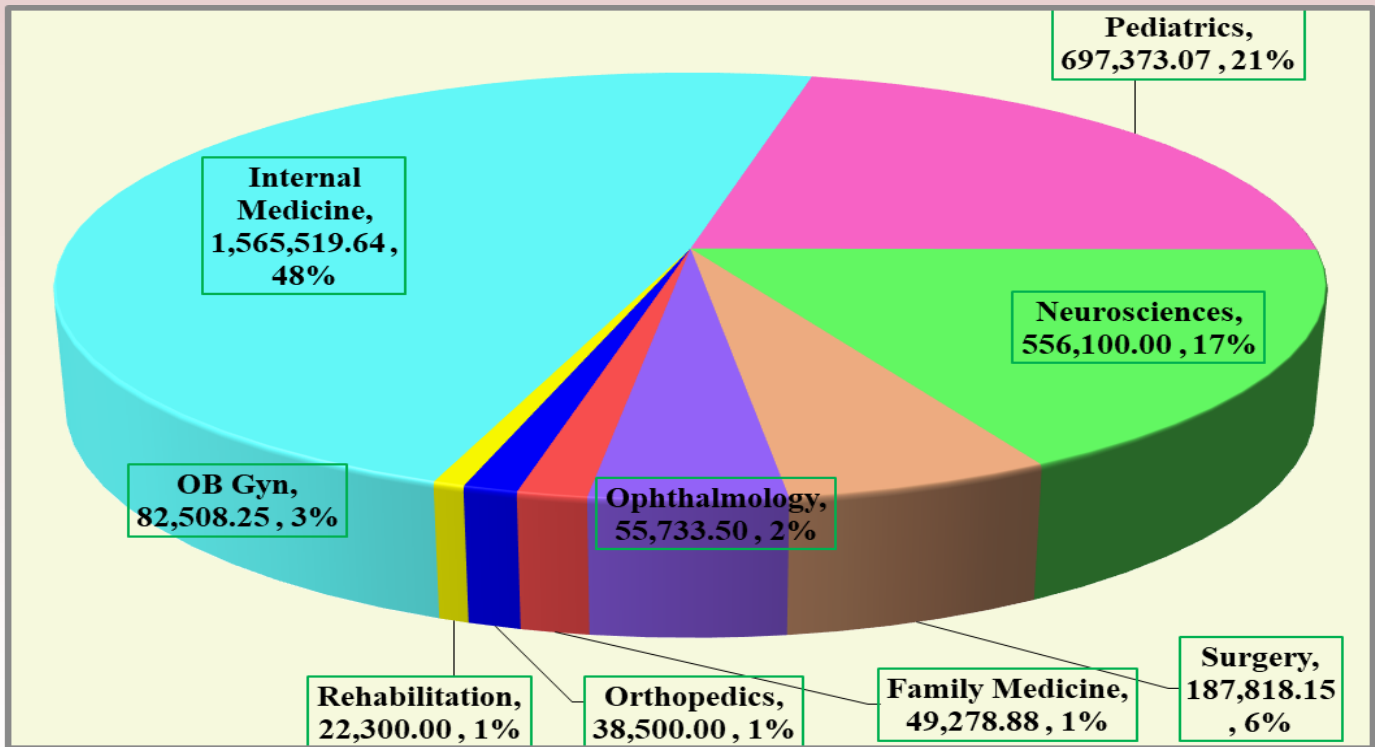





Our patient, **MANUCAN, JOHN FELIX "Tan Tan", 8 yo, male** has been admitted in our institution since September 24, 2022 as a case of Subarachnoid hemorrhages Posterior fossa pial arteriovenous malformation and pseudoaneurysm with secondary obstructive hydrocephalus, and subarachnoid and intraventricular hemorrhage. In order to prevent fatal complications of this condition, several procedures were done to the patient and as follows:

S/P tracheostomy under GETA (12/26/22, PGH), s/p change of trache (1/16/23, PGH)
S/P femoral catheter insertion, right (1/25/23)
S/P femoral catheter insertion, right (1/1/23), removal (1/23/23)
S/P right parietal VPS insertion under GE-trache (1/16/23, PGH)
S/P right parietal EVD insertion under GETA (1/4/23, PGH), removal (1/16/23, PGH)
S/P right frontal EVD insertion (12/20/22, PGH), removal (1/4/2023, PGH)
S/P right frontal EVD insertion (10/11/2022, PGH), removal (11/15/2022, PGH)
S/P left frontal EVD insertion (11/15/2022, PGH), removal (12/20/2022)

Tan Tan's condition is stable but it made him bed ridden for the rest of his life. He is already under hospice care and advised palliative practices at home. Patient per evaluation is suitable for home ventilation. The Department of Pediatrics has tapped and outsourced all available agencies known to the department and was able to find a suitable home ventilator for our patient. To further aid in the home care of Tantan, the following needs were identified:

Generator Php 18,000- 20,000
Oxygen tank Php 7,500-9,500
Ambubag - 2500-5000
Nebulizer - 2000-5000
Suction Machine with Suction catheters - 3,500 - 6000

Tan Tan and his family, together with the Department of Pediatrics is in deep gratitude to your office for providing funds to cover for some of the patient's home care needs, specifically, the oxygen tank amounting to Php 9,500.

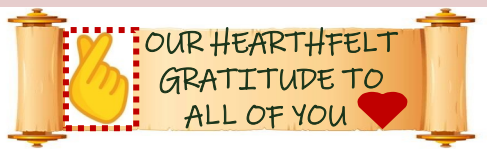
