Medical Social Service (MSS) Testimonies

Many perhaps up to this time are not so familiar with the entirety of the nature of work that Social Workers do in the hospital to help our patients. We “play doctors”, since we are in a hospital setting, we practice STUDY... DIAGNOSE... and TREAT our patients. As Medical Social Workers...we **STUDY** the cases/ condition/ and situation of patients and their families in order to assess & establish the problem areas for work in each patient’s case. In this encounter with patients we do not only look into their financial capability but also learn about their family dynamics, their relationship, how they interact with each other, and identify possible problem areas that we would need to work out during confinement as this would have effect and impact on the process of treatment.



On **DIAGNOSIS**, we find out probable cause of the problem areas, do collateral interviews with relatives, friends and significant others to augment on the presenting problem/ symptoms presented and plan actions/ interventions to solve/ address the problems. The Social Worker connects with agencies that can possibly help them after the treatment, integration back to their home, to the community. In this stage the Social Worker having discovered significant problem areas now plans on what and how to resolve problems. The Social Worker involves the patient’s participation, contracting with them that certain problems have to be resolve.

And lastly **TREATMENT**, where and when SW implements the plan of actions and interventions; we do not administer medicines but provide solutions on where and how to be able to access proper treatment/ medications thru referrals for assistance; we also provide counseling not only with patients but the whole family; we also tie up with different agencies providing social services like shelter, medical equipment/ devices for after care could be wheel chair, oxygen tank/ oxygenator, suction machine, bi-pap/ c-pap and sometimes mechanical ventilator.

Apart from the material aspects, we do a lot of counseling with families, discharge planning, and location of relatives especially for vagrants and abandoned individuals, hence we have partnered with LGU Sw, the barangays and the police authorities.

In all our encounter with patients we cannot forget the huge contribution of the PGH Medical Foundation in serving our patients, because when MSS lacks the resources, the Foundation is always there ready to help us help our patients. One unforgettable help we owe PGH Med Found is during the Pandemic, when Covid stricken patients’ needs to be admitted and isolated, that there is no one to comfort patients at their lowest moment, when patients feel discriminated for the highly contagious disease, while us SWs also feel so anxious on our own health if we get near to patients to perform our duties and serve our patients; when SWs also worries on transmitting the infection to their own families when they get home...when there is no other way to communicate with patients and their families ...



To this date the Foundation has not ceased in helping our patients; providing life sustaining devices and even payment of diagnostic examinations not available then in our hospital. With these, we continue to thank and acknowledge the Foundation for their invaluable help and generosity to our patients.

Our customers look at the PGH coin banks with deep respect. The three letters- PGH - is a recognized beacon of hope for the sick and ailing in the Philippines. With PGH, indigent patients can expect compassionate and quality care. The PGH reputation gives the coin banks a strong attraction.

Recently, a man left a sack of coins in one of our stores. He instructed the Pandayan employees to send the coins to the PGH Medical Foundation. The store staff wanted to count the coins before he left. He said it was not necessary. He was confident that the employees will see to it that the money reaches its right destination.

Time and again, people are surprised when they learn that Pandayan employees do not accept tips. If the customers insist, employees will ask permission from the customer if it is all right to put the tip in the PGH coin bank. The customers always agree. Once in a while, they add more money to the foundation- bound tip.

Money left and unclaimed by customers also goes to the coin banks. The ' pulot' money is recorded before it is put in a coin bank. You will be amazed at how many purses, wallets, and cellphones are left in our stores. If a Pandayan employee finds a lost item, customers can rest assured that they will get it back.

Our thanks go to Dr. Telesforo Gana, Jr. who has guided the PGH Medical Foundation from the very beginning. He and his fellow volunteers at the foundation can rest assured that their legacy will continue to benefit many generations of Filipinos. While the money budgeted by the government for the PGH hospital goes to programmed expenses, the funds of the foundation enable the hospital to cope with myriad unexpected expenses.

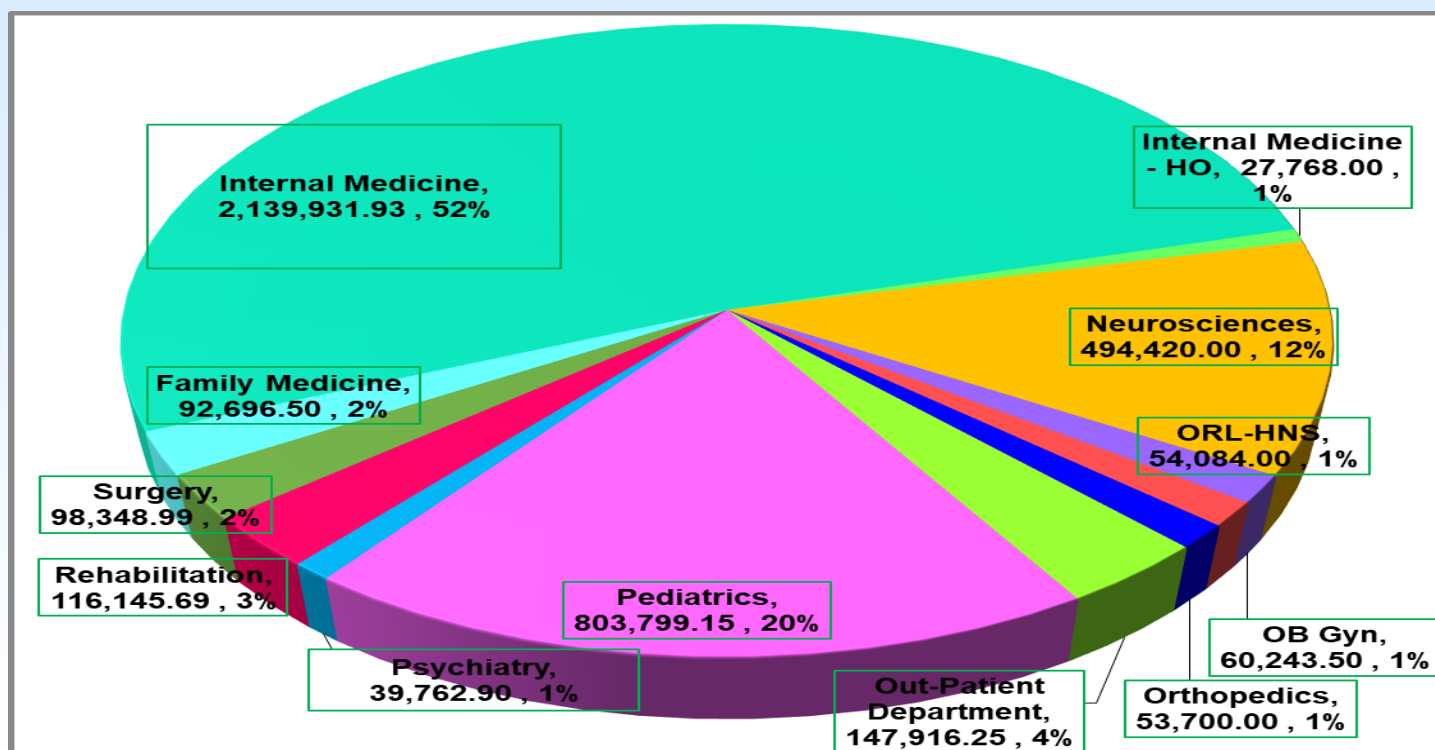

Delirium, considerations: 1) fentanyl-induced (toxicity versus withdrawal); 2) ICU psychosis on top of "chronic" encephalopathy (hydrocephalus ex vacuo) from previous insults: 1) HIE (ACLS x 6 minutes); 2) sepsis; 3) metabolic causes (previous hyponatremia, pancreatitis); 4) chronic alcoholism
ARF, resolving, mixed: 1) type 1 from: a) aspiration pneumonitis; b) VAP (CRAB, PAE, SMA); 2) upper airway obstruction from pooling of oral secretions, on top of CRF from deconditioned state
—w/ tracheostomy (6/19/24, PCN)
PTB, BC, ongoing intensive phase treatment
Recurrent MEI (hypoNa, hypok, hypomg) from adrenal insufficiency and PMB tubulopathy
